Planning For Your Child's Future—A Transition Guide for Butler County

Now that eligibility has been determined for Intellectual/ Developmental Disability Waiver services, follow this guide to plan for your child's needs while at home and for transitioning from School to Adult Services.

Age 5—14

- Apply to the social Security Administration for Supplemental Security Income (SSI).
- Apply for medical card at https://cssp.kees.ks.gov
- Assure you have Targeted Case Management services
- Assure your child has been placed on the waiting list for I/DD Waiver.

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Age 15-17

- School Transition services will be discussed at IEP meetings. Begin Planning for adult living and employment options
- Have Social Security Card available
- Have Kansas ID or Driver's License available.
- Discuss the need for Guardianship, Conservatorship, Durable Power of Attorney, or a Representative Payee once your child turns 18.
- Discuss estate planning issues
- Discuss adult service options in the area, ask about agency waiting lists, set up tours with Community Service Providers.
- Prior to graduation, discuss transition to adult service options with I/DD Case manager.

Age 18

- Reapply for Supplemental Security Income as an adult. www.ssa.gov
- Reapply for Medicaid as an adult. https://cssp.kees.ks.gov
- All 18 year old males must register for selective services.

Before Exiting School

- Assure I/DD adult services are in place with your Targeted Case Manager and Managed Care Organization.
